LT – Welcomed everyone back to the school council after the summer break, School Council had new photos taken for the Notice Board.

Sports Day – Went really well everyone enjoyed, this could be an annual event, if pupils are happy to organise the School Council could take the lead.

Homework - LT reported that school has listened to the pupils and agreed that too much homework was initially given. Two pieces of homework are now given out, one piece of Maths and one piece of English, this should take about 25 minutes to complete. LT records homework that is handed back in. If homework is handed back for 7 weeks pupils will get an extra reward.

Pass System – LT discusses with the group that pupils can apply to upgrade their current pass, LT will look at each individual pass request, if permission is granted pupils will move up. If a pupil is currently on a yellow pass and then climbs the fence they will not then move up. The Pass system is run on a level of trust. Passes can be withheld for a week if pupils have behaviour issues. If poor behaviour continues the pupils pass will be demoted. Passes will be reviewed regularly. NL - Discussions will be held with Education and Residential.

Isolation Unit – LT reported that ILST will be used as an isolation unit if a pupil is behaving dangerously, if a pupil completes all their work, and behaviour improves they can rejoin the class after lunch. LT mentions to the group that it is not a good place to be, it is very boring.

Funds available for the Recreation Room – LT asked the group for ideas, JC mentioned an Air Hockey table, NL would like to see more posters, Student council all agreed that posters of football clubs, Man United, Manchester City, Chelsea were just a few ideas , JC – posters of football stadiums and players. LT will look at the budget available.

School Meals – BS to look at meal options with pupils and report any substitutes, of unpopular meal choices.

Tuck Shop – BD and DE are looking into running the tuck shop, to raise money for the Year 11 leaver's trip. NL – enquired if the profit could be split between the year 11 trip and the recreation room. JL mentioned a vending machine, LT replied that an

outside company would manage and receive the profit. Year 11's need to raise money for the leaver's trip. LT School council need to collect a list of popular items to sell.

A.O.B – BS enquired about a bike track around the school field, LT will make enquiries to cost and practicality. JD & BS asked about Xbox Gold internet connection. JD also suggested a rock climbing wall, JS would also like the mugger (outdoor pitch) to be changed to a 3G all-weather outdoor pitch. LT will report back on costs.
