MEETING MINUTES
<p>Meeting opened at 9.40 am</p> <p>Tom (ISS catering Manager) and Curtis (the new ISS school cook) were invited to discuss the current menu</p> <p>The members went through the menu and the following comments were made:</p> <p>Clarification on the cheese used on pizzas and whether they could be presented in a different format – i.e. slice rather than a baguette</p> <p>ISS are reviewing the alternative to the vegetarian option as there is not a take up of that option, thought the kitchen does intend to offer it,</p> <p>ISS asked opinion on the Introduction of a salad bar, with the protein (egg, ham, cheese etc.) stored separately and provided on request and the staff/pupils able to serve themselves. This was greeted favourably and school council hope this can begin as soon as possible</p> <p>Panini day very popular and school council was assured this would continue. FL brought up the twice a week offer. He was reminded that he can change his order weekly and to tell Lidia on the Monday what he would like for the week. Lidia will be informed of this, so she can help FL remember to do it.</p> <p>There was a discussion about seasoning – for example salty chips and tasteless cous cous. Tom assured the school council that he will look into this and work with Curtis on taste testing.</p> <p>Chicken bones – This had already been addressed and it was an ordering issue, which has now been rectified and the school has been assured this will not happen again.</p> <p>Spaghetti Bolognese was suggested as an option. Tom said that as there was lasagne on the menu, Spaghetti Bolognese can be made that week instead. The kitchen would inform the admin office on the Monday if there was a change such as this to the menu.</p> <p>Desserts:</p> <p>Requests for more biscuits, buns, jelly pots, fruit salad, ice-cream</p>
