Lordline Building and St. Andrew's Quay Area

Prior to the summer holidays in 2018 Karen Kearney wrote to you about concerns around the Lordline building and St Andrews Quay Area.

Since this letter the Council has issued further notices on the owners. We have been made aware from our contacts at the emergency services and through social media trespassing on the site continues.

I have received some urgent correspondence this week from Environmental Health, Humberside Fire and Rescue, City Planning, and Hull Regeneration regarding the Lordline building, and other surrounding buildings on St. Andrew's Quay.

These buildings have been in a state of disrepair for some time, and last year we asked schools to warn children to stay away from this area.

Concerns were raised, that a number of school aged children have still been frequenting this area. The Council along with its partners in the emergency services are deeply concerned for the welfare of people who visit the site. This is given to the nature of the site, and hazards amongst it.

Ahead of the school holidays could you please inform your staff, children & parents that they must not under any circumstance venture around this area, as these buildings are all unsafe.
