OUTCOMES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

<p>Pupils welcomed back to Oakfield.</p> <p>Explanation of why the rec room has been moved to room 7 (to accommodate the two new nurture classes in room 1 and 2).</p> <p>Key Dates for Autumn Term 1: 23/9- Key worker sessions 17/10 Farmers Market 24/10 Theme day</p> <p>The number of pupils has increased and as a result, clubs are getting busier at break, lunch and on a Friday. Retro games is now offered on a break and lunch. Pupils asked what clubs they would like to see offered- boxing and biking both suggested for a Friday.</p> <p>The school are starting a new marking policy from this academic year. All work will be marked lightly on a day to day basis so pupils can see what they have got correct and where they may have made mistakes. At the end of 3/4 lessons a more detailed written description of successes will be provided by the teacher and circled in green. Along with this will be a question to investigate or consolidate learning. This will require a response by the pupil. Examples were shown to the pupils.</p> <p>AOB</p> <p><b>Can the mugga changed to astro turf?</b> LT explained that this has been discussed before and a quote was received but was very expensive. LT suggested that if there was sufficient interest then 'goals' could be potentially offered on a Friday which has astro turf. This would free up the sports hall for other activities such as badminton, tennis, climbing wall.</p> <p><b>Faster computers-</b> the computers have now been updated to windows 10 and it is not the operating system that is slowing down the computers but rather the computers are of a certain age and new computers will be installed in the future as part of the schools contract with RM.</p> <p><b>Larger storage on computers.</b> All pupils currently have the same amount- if storage is full then a member of the SLT team will look at what is stored- if the pupils computer storage is full of academic work then a solution will be looked into but generally when a pupil does max out their storage it is off non-academic related context.</p>

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**Can the school have a swimming pool?** the answer to this unfortunately is no and that is due to the cost implications. Swimming is offered every Friday and end of term as a reward. The two Year 7 nurture classes will be attending swimming lessons as part of the curriculum and this is planned for the spring term.
