

Home School Agreement (COVID-19)

The aim of this policy is to outline the safety procedures currently adopted by Oakfield staff and pupils in order to manage the risk from the current Covid 19 infection. The following procedures are a means to reduce the risk of contracting the Covid 19 virus or transmitting it within Oakfield School and amongst the adults and young people who attend. It is a practical way of managing the infection to the best of our ability. The school will be operating very differently during its partial closure. Any child's offer of a place at school is subject to the following document. If this cannot be adhered to, children will not be able to be in school.

<p>The school will do its best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection; ● Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as possible; ● Inform you if staff or children in school show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative; ● Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement; ● Communicate between home and school through text, letters and the school 	<p>To help my child at school, I know and understand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone; ● If my child, or another child in the school shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately; ● My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell ● I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules ● My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene; 	<p>I will do my best to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and in the school environment ; ● Tell an adult if I feel unwell; ● Only enter and exit the school building from the designated front entrance ; ● Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it); ● Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitizer. ● Handwashing before and after eating is important. All pupils will use the Hand Wash Station in the KS4 hub before entering the canteen. ● Behave well at all times to maintain

<p>website.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email; • I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this crisis; • Read all letters/messages that are sent home; • I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details. • If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. 	<p>the safety of myself and others; (Behaviour from pupils that would require physical management from staff cannot be managed at this time and therefore will not be able to attend school)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All pupils to complete work packs during tutor (09.00-10.00) • Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
