Attendance reminder to all parents/carers

Oakfield School have been working in partnership with various agencies across the city to encourage pupils back into education/school, we very much appreciate this pandemic has had a profound effect on our pupil's education, emotional wellbeing and wider social impacts.

We would like to thank parents/carers for the commitment and cooperation you have shown the school during this extremely difficult time.

We need to reminder all parents and carers that as of the 8th March 2021 Government Guidance changed in relation to attendance and once again school attendance was made mandatory.

This means all children of compulsory school age **MUST** attend school

Schools are required by law to record attendance and follow up all non-attendance. This means that Attendance Protocols will be followed for all non-attendance.

The local Authority can now issue legal sanctions, which include fixed penalty notices, they may enforce a prosecution in court for lack of attendance, these are in line with codes of conduct.

If you have concerns about your child attending school or your child is experiencing anxieties you must contact the school, so we can support your child with their attendance.

Over the past year there has been so much disruption it is now very important we continue to work together to engage your child back into education.
