MONEY MATTERS

An **Employer-Led Apprenticeship** means you are employed by a company, and you will receive a wage of at least £5.28 per hour (from April 2023).

Whilst doing a **Study Programme/Traineeship**, your parents can continue to claim Child Benefit and possibly Child Tax Credits for you. You may be able to access additional financial support from training provider's Bursary Funds, dependent on individual circumstances. If you no longer live with parents/carers, speak to Connexions about other financial support that may be available to you i.e., Income Support.

STUDY PROGRAMMES & TRAINEESHIPS

If you are unable to go straight onto an Apprenticeship for whatever reason, then there are various pre-apprenticeship programmes you could consider applying for.

Study Programmes (SP) – study programmes are ideal for young people with few or no grades, who need to improve confidence and/or literacy and numeracy skills.

Traineeships (TR) - These programmes are targeted at young people who are ready to start an apprenticeship, but don't have a placement with an employer. Candidates must be capable of achieving a level 2 qualification, acceptance onto these programmes may be through an initial assessment and/or certain grades may be required. The Traineeship programme should provide work experience placements. Listed below are SOME of the training providers offering Traineeships locally (this list is not exhaustive).

GENERAL ADVICE FOR APPLICANTS

Work hard in school to gain the best exam results you can. Good grades in core subjects are often asked for by employers/training providers particularly for popular apprenticeships e.g., Motor Vehicle, Electrical Installations and Plumbing.

Most training providers will expect you to look for a placement i.e., an employer to take you on whilst you do your training. Contact local companies to ask if they are recruiting apprentices. Look in the Hull Colour Pages or www.yell.com

Be prepared to take an aptitude test/assessment particularly for engineering, motor vehicle and construction apprenticeships.

Fully prepare for any interviews you are offered. Dress smartly, arrive on time and answer questions fully, etc.

Apply for full-time education courses too. Apprenticeships are very popular and there may be limited places available. Keep in touch with Connexions because training providers and employers sometimes contact Connexions when they have vacancies.
